The duration of the test will be 1 hour and 45 minutes only with multiple choice questions based on text. For the operator/supervisor certification there will be 75 questions. For the CELC operator there will be 50 questions. Based on the aggregate grades scored in the test, candidates will be certified either as a supervisor or registration operatorThe candidate who ensures equal to or greater than 50% of the maximum grades will receive the Supervisor certificate.The candidate who achieves 40% or greater than 50% will pass the test as an operator and receive the operator certificate. In accordance with the aggregate grades scored in the test, the candidates will be certified as Celc OperatorThe candidate who gets more than 40% in the CELC Exam will be declared a pass and will receive certificate from the celc operator. The candidate who gets less than 40% will be declared suspended and, therefore, no certificate will be generated in such cases.
